Who can benefit from the Charity?

Pupils of the six Stafford high schools and ex-pupils up to the age of 25.

For School Pupils;

Grants are available through schools to pupils of low-income families, for such needs as school uniform and sportswear or to meet the costs of educational visits, so ensuring that they can be fully integrated with their fellow pupils in all activities.

For Ex-Pupils;

Grants are available to help with and promote activities which cannot be funded by schools, e.g.,
